1. Discussion and action on recommendation from Plan Commission to adopt the 5-Year Park & Recreation Plan.

M. DeYoe reported on matters considered and actions taken at the meeting. The last Plan Commission meeting was the Hartland Sportman's Club Public Hearing. There was some regular business attended to; an item on the Consent Agenda, a new nail salon on Milwaukee Street.

M. DeYoe stated the Plan Commission and Common Council will be holding a joint meeting on Thursday, June 10, 2010 to act on the Hartland Sportman's Club.

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c. Lake Welfare Committee

1. Discussion and possible action on a lake level change request to the DNR.

L. Morrison stated in 1990, lake residents requested that the DNR allowed the lake level be lowered to absorb extra water during heavy rains. The DNR granted it with the condition that it must be lowered during the first two weeks of October and raised the first two weeks of March because of the amphibians and reptiles in the lake during the winter. This action hasn't met the original expectation as we have seen with spring rains over the years coming after March. Since we haven't been able to dredge, it's a double whammy in October; the boats are left high and dry. The Lake Welfare Committee wants to work with DNR on this, discuss it at the Annual Lake Awareness meeting and get Common Council approval. T. Hafner stated he agrees with the request.

**L. MORRISON MOVED TO STATE THAT THE COMMON COUNCIL AGREES WITH THE CONCEPT OF NOT LOWERING THE LAKE LEVEL AND TO SEND A REQUEST TO THE DNR OF THE SAME. G. MACDOUGALL SECONDED THE MOTION. THERE WAS NO FURTHER DISCUSSION. ALL WERE IN FAVOR. MOTION CARRIED.**

L. Morrison stated the Annual Lake Awareness meeting is Wednesday, June 9, 2010 at Christ the King Lutheran Church from 6:30 to 9:30 pm. Topics include: Dredging Plan B Committee, dredging, lake levels, state of the lake and new pier regulations. Anyone who has an interest in the lake should make it to the meeting.

2. Discussion and possible action to ask the DNR for extension of the Chapter 30 permit.

L. Morrison stated the DNR Chapter 30 permit expires December 31, 2010 and suggested the Common Council request a two year extension from the DNR.

d. Park and Recreation Commission – (Minutes of May 26, 2010)

T. Aicher stated based on the Common Council's recommendations, the Commission is working with a UW Madison Intern for landscaping and park architecture for Oakwood Park. They will be using a student who needs outreach work to finish their Masters Degree. The cost is minimal, way below the \$30,000 in the budget. Commission member David Brabson is also doing great work with the Lois Jensen trail and that parking is on the trail's punch list of items to address. L. Morrison suggested adding the Watershed Signs to the Intern project.

e. Public Works Committee – (Minutes of June 2, 2010)

G. MacDougall stated the Committee discussed the Golf Road feasibility study findings. The Common Council will see a presentation on the two recommendations at the next meeting. Also, the Cushing Park Road / Main Street business park signage was postponed for the engineer to do some research. The next Public Works Committee meeting is July 7, 2010 at 6:30 P.M. at the Fish Hatchery.

f. Del-Hart Commission – (Minutes of May 18, 2010)

There was nothing to report at this time.

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g. Police Commission

There was nothing to report at this time.

h. Library Board

There was nothing to report at this time. The next Library Board meeting is June 8, 2010 at 7:00 P.M.

i. Board of Zoning – (Minutes of May 27, 2010)

G. MacDougall stated the two variances on the agenda were both granted. The next Board of Zoning meeting is Thursday, June 24, 2010 at 7:30 P.M.

j. Promotional and Tourism Committee – (Minutes of June 1, 2010)

L. Morrison stated donations were granted to pay for City banners and advertising for the Block Party, Hawks Inn roof fundraiser and for the Art Walk. The Art Walk was quite successful. Upcoming events include the 5K Run/Walk on Saturday, June 19. The Block Party is Friday, July 9 and Saturday, July 10.

k. Lake Country Fire Commission

There was nothing to report at this time.

l. Lake Country Fire Board – (Minutes of May 19, 2010)

G. MacDougall stated things coming together very well since the Lake Country Fire & Rescue Department was accepted into WRS. The Fire Board terminated the employee lease agreement with the City of Delafield and accepted the transfer of fire equipment from the prior Lake Country Fire Department. The next Lake Country Fire Board meeting is June 16, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. at the Fire Station #2.

m. Dredging Plan B Committee – (Minutes of May 19, 2010)

B. Leonard stated the Committee discussed several issues in detail, one of them being a possible lake management district. They also voted on a statement which said the committee is not recommending a lake management district unless all other recommendations are not agreed to by the Common Council. T. Aicher stated a lake management district would be the City's last resort. There was further discussion about a lake management district and that it would take taxing authority away from the Common Council. T. Aicher stated there is a process to creating a lake management district and anyone at anytime could start that process without the Dredging Plan B Committee's input.

B. Leonard stated they also received budget information. In 2009, the City spent \$57,000 on operating costs for the lake. That does not include debt service or capital expenditures. She stated they also discussed a possible stormwater utility as another funding source. The concept is that every property in watershed contributes to runoff into the lake. This would accurately determine how much runoff they have by measuring impervious surface, then assessing a charge. This is very preliminary. Committee Chair Al Zietlow will be giving a brief presentation at the Lake Awareness meeting.

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## 5. Unfinished Business

a. LOMR Update – *May 27, 2010 letter from FEMA*

DPW Director T. Hafner stated the City received a response from FEMA, which acknowledges the flows in the original model were double what they should have been and can go back to the way they were. B. Leonard asked if this is close the original levels. T. Hafner stated yes, and the levels could be a couple of tenths better. T. Hafner stated this issue will be completed this year.

## b. Discussion and action to adopt Ordinance No. 639, An Ordinance To Create Section 7.12 of the Municipal Code of the City of Delafield, Waukesha County, Wisconsin Related to Low Speed Vehicles.

J. Krickhahn stated he has been following this through the legislature and it has been modified five times. The law is no longer designed for Neighborhood Electric Vehicles. It is now for Low Speed Vehicles that use propane powers and different fuels. His only concern is that the ordinance was written for speeds up to 25 mph, even though the law states it must be able to hold a speed of 35 mph.
