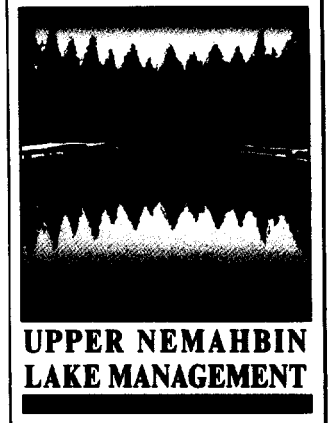

Dear Mr. Schuman,

In 2001 the Upper Nemahbin Lake Management District (UNLMD), under a WDNR Lake Planning Grant, investigated the middle Bark River watershed that is shared by the City of Delafield and the UNLMD. The East-West area extends from the Fish Hatchery Dam to the Bark River inlet to Upper Nemahbin Lake.

As a follow-up the District is now interested in obtaining a WDNR Lake Planning Grant for further examination of the impounded portions of the middle Bark River watershed. The results of this study would provide information to formulate a plan to protect the stream bank from degradation in the City's jurisdiction and improve the water quality of Upper Nemahbin Lake.

WDNR grant applications are ranked competitively statewide. An important approval determinant are letters of support from other levels of government. For this reason the City of Delafield's support of this project in our common watershed would be appreciated.

Mr. Mentkowski, Chairman of the UNLMD, will be traveling during the current season and requested that I assemble the documents to be included in the grant application. Please direct the City's written resolution of support to the undersigned at:
