



Conflict with N. Vietnam (guerrilla forces) and S. Vietnam (U.S.)

The Geneva Conference credited 17° N Lat. as the divisional point between North and South. This division created a civil war with limited international conflict, but with the United States becoming deeply involved.

In 1973 peace agreements were not carried out and in 1975 N. Vietnam gained control of S. Vietnam

#### MEMORIAL COMPONENTS

The large unit paver field allows for a wealth of donation space along with a larger outdoor plaza for events.

The large Memorial Marker Stone creates a prominent feature that viewers congregate towards. Rising out of a bed of stones it stands to support the conflict and its veterans

The strict symmetry of the site contrasts with the moss garden and adjacent surroundings. This memorial is purposefully orchestrated to honor the veterans and the war, while acting as a destination along the VMR.
