### City of Delafield Accepting Applications For Deer Management Program

City of Delafield - The City of Delafield is now accepting applications for archery and crossbow hunting using nuisance tags from the DNR. The season is from 9/16/2023 - 1/31/2024.

You must complete the Deer Management Program Bow Hunter Application online to qualify for the use of a City of Delafield nuisance tag or to hunt from a City of Delafield deer stand. Please visit [www.cityofdelafield.com](http://www.cityofdelafield.com) and go to Community Services>Deer Management to complete the Bow Hunter Application and for additional information regarding the City of Delafield Deer Management Program. Once approved, the applicant will be sent a link to access our hunt scheduler. Nuisance tags can only be used for antler-less deer. You may use your own state-issued buck tags in one of our 6 stands. Trail cameras have been added this

season to better identify and share deer movement patterns. There will be no CWD testing requirement for deer that are not brought to a food pantry. If hunters wish to have their deer tested, they may still do so through the normal hunter CWD testing provided by the DNR.

## CITY of Delafield accepting applications for deer management program

City of Delafield- The City of Delafield is now accepting applications for archery and crossbow hunting using nuisance tags from the DNR. The season starts from 9/16-1/31/2024.

Applications should be sent to [cityofdelafield.com/515/deer-management](http://cityofdelafield.com/515/deer-management)

Nuisance tags can only be used for antler-less deer. You may use your own state-issued buck tags in one of our 6 stands.

Once approved, the applicant will be sent a link to access our hunt scheduler. Trail cameras have been added this season to better identify and share deer movement patterns.

There will be no CWD testing requirement for deer that are not brought to a food pantry. If hunters wish to have their deer tested, they may still do so through the normal hunter CWD testing provided by the DNR.
