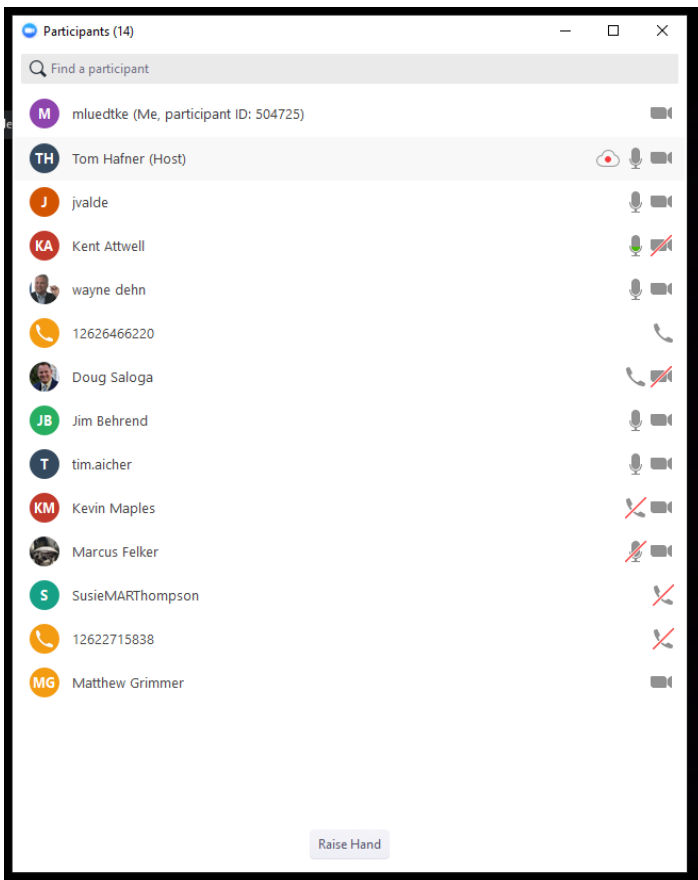

- b. Discussion and possible action regarding Resolution 2020-04, a Resolution Designating Emergency Responders for Purposes of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act and Excluding Emergency Responders from Eligibility for the Leave Provided Under the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.

Tom Hafner explained this act includes provision for health care providers and emergency responders to exclude them from the provisions of the act. This will allow for proper staffing in the future to take care of current and future emergencies. There are differences in who is considered emergency responders. This is a recommendation from the Labor Attorney. Tom Hafner's recommendation is within the Resolution.

**MOTION BY ALDERMAN BEHREND, SECOND BY ALDERMAN MAPLES, TO APPROVE RESOLUTION 2020-04, A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING EMERGENCY RESPONDERS FOR PURPOSES OF THE FAMILIES FIRST CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ACT AND EXCLUDING EMERGENCY RESPONDERS FROM ELIGIBILITY FOR THE LEAVE PROVIDED UNDER THE FAMILIES FIRST CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ACT.**
