NOTICE OF PATH CONSTRUCTION

2020 Street Improvement Program
City of Delafield, WI
August 3, 2020

NAGAWICKA ROAD

Dear Property Owner:

The City of Delafield will soon be constructing a path along Nagawicka Road. The path will be located on the east side between the intersections of Oakwood Road and Zastrow Road, then switch to the west side of the road between the intersections of Zastrow Road and Price Road. General path construction will be performed by All-Ways Contractors, Inc. Site activity is anticipated to start the week of August 10, 2020. Work is anticipated to be completed by October 30, 2020. These dates are subject to change due to inclement weather conditions.

As mentioned earlier, site activity will begin as early as August 10th, with surveying marking out project limits. Then the following three weeks, City DPW staff will perform brush and tree maintenance, and WE Energies and Charter Communication will relocate select existing utility poles. Starting in early September, All-Ways Contractors, Inc. will begin the path construction, starting on the south end by Oakwood Road.

Path construction includes the removal of existing driveway culverts with installation of storm sewer and inlets in the existing ditch line; grading and compacting of base course aggregate; removal and replacement of any unstable spots in the path base course; removal and replacement of approximately 10 feet of driveway to match the new grades; installation of the new asphalt surface for path and driveways; and any site restoration.

Project work should not significantly impact your overall ability to access your property, except for short periods, while the work is being performed immediately in front of your driveway. Prior notification will be provided to you, before any driveway work will be performed. During the project you should expect narrow drive lanes and flagging operations along Nagawicka Road. Also gravel patches and dust may be present at times. During construction the area will be open to only local traffic, no thru traffic will be allowed. No street parking will be allowed during the day while work is in progress.

Construction activities will cause some short-term inconveniences. It is our intention to minimize these inconveniences as much as practically possible. For everyone's safety please drive at a reduced speed, do not talk on a cell phone, expect delays, and be patient. Also please keep pets and children away from the construction activities.
