



**ORDER RELATING TO A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE POSITION OF ALDERMANIC DISTRICT 4**

**WHEREAS**, Wayne Dehn won the April 5, 2022 election for the District 4 Alderperson seat for a two-year term expiring on April 15, 2024.

**WHEREAS**, Wayne Dehn has submitted his resignation from his District 4 Alderperson seat, effective April 3, 2023, which will thereby create a vacancy pursuant to §17.03(2), Wis. Stats.; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Delafield that the seat to be vacated on April 3, 2023 of alderperson for Aldermanic District 4 be filled as soon as possible, which can be by a Special Election of the electors of Aldermanic District 4, and

**WHEREAS**, on Monday, November 21, 2022 the Common Council, by motion made, seconded and duly adopted, moved to hold a Special Election for the vacant aldermanic seat in Aldermanic District 4 on Tuesday, April 4, 2023 as authorized by §17.23(1)(am), Wis. Stats.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** by the Common Council of the City of Delafield that a special election be held to fill the vacant aldermanic seat in Aldermanic District 4 of the City of Delafield on Tuesday, April 4, 2023, and that the timing for circulation and filing of nomination papers and the primary, if necessary, be as follows:


- A primary election, if necessary, shall be held on Tuesday, February 21, 2023.
- Nomination Papers may be circulated beginning Thursday, December 1, 2022.
- Nomination Papers must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 3, 2023.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** that the term of the alderperson elected by the electors of Aldermanic District 4 will be for the remainder of the term vacated by Wayne Dehn, which will expire April 15, 2024.
